Frequently Asked Questions

What does The Janus School do?

For nearly two decades, The Janus School has helped unlock the academic potential in students with learning differences. We use proven techniques to help children learn, not just until the next bell rings, but for the rest of their lives.

Why is this campaign important?

Students with learning differences are up against monstrous odds—25 million American students, for instance, are functionally illiterate because of either an undiagnosed or neglected learning disability. The Janus School is the only school in South Central Pennsylvania dedicated to helping students with learning differences.

In turn, the community, indeed the world, benefits from great minds unlocked through the proven learning techniques employed by The Janus School.

Why does The Janus School need to expand?

The expansion is a testament to the school's success—it is the next stage of evolution to assure students have a well-rounded educational experience. The school has done all the creative juggling it can with the existing space. Our first campaign, which was most successful, originally included plans for a gymnasium, presentation platform, locker rooms and cafeteria, but these did not make the final cut because funding did

not cover these “extras.” The money raised was channeled into the hiring of specialized educators and a building that allowed for flexibility as well as for individualized instruction.

There's a perception that The Janus School is exclusive, is this true?

No. We presently work with over 25 school districts throughout Pennsylvania, as well as offer scholarships to over 20 percent of our students. The endowment portion of the capital campaign is designed to produce \$50,000 in direct scholarships each year, with more planned as the student body grows and new gifts are added. With expansion and renovation comes a heightened and sustained marketing effort. The new, permanent endowment will be grown over the years to ensure affordability for all who need it.

Over how many years may I make my pledge?

Pledges may be made over as many as five years, with the campaign designed to run through 2009.

Will my gift be tax deductible?

Gifts made to The Janus School are tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law because we are a 501(c)3 organization. We suggest you contact your tax planner for the most tax wise manner in which to make your gift.

Ways to Give

Your gift will not only benefit

The Janus School but could result in financial advantages for you. We urge you to seek tax advice from your financial advisor to receive the full tax benefits of your gift.

Cash and Check Contributions.

Cash and checks are always accepted. Please make checks payable to The Janus School and indicate “Capital Campaign” on the memo line.

Appreciated Securities.

Transferring appreciated securities may reduce or eliminate capital gains tax. For instance, if you own highly-appreciated stock, selling that stock and making your gift in cash may incur unnecessary capital gains taxes that could be avoided by directly transferring the stock to The Janus School. Please contact The Janus School development office for stock transfer instructions.

Decreased Value Securities.

Conversely, if the current value of your securities is less than the original cost, it may be wise to sell the stock and make a gift with the cash proceeds. This gives you a charitable benefit for both the loss in its value and a deduction for the gift.

Gifts of Appreciated Real Estate.

Under certain circumstances, The Janus School may accept gifts of appreciated real estate upon recommendation from its Board of Directors. By making a gift of a residence, farm or vacation home, you may avoid capital gains taxes and receive a charitable deduction for the full market value of the property.

Gifts of Retirement Funds.

Are you already well-positioned for retirement tomorrow and more interested in tax relief today? This option may allow you to transfer a portion of your IRA funds to The Janus School and realize positive tax advantages.

Planned Giving.

In addition to current gifts that will support the objectives of the campaign, planned estate gifts are very important to The Janus School's future. There are a number of options for creating a planned gift in your estate, including charitable trusts, gift annuity trusts, outright bequests, and life insurance. These gifts should be considered within the full framework of your estate and after seeking counsel from your tax and/or legal advisors.
